



**2010 UCI CYCLO-CROSS MASTERS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS**  
**Mol / Belgium**  
**Saturday 23 January 2010**

Situated in the eastern part of Antwerp Province, the municipality of Mol has approximately 32'000 inhabitants. Mol is the biggest municipality of Belgium. The Provincial Domain Zilvermeer Mol will welcome the 2010 UCI Cyclo-Cross Masters World Championships on the upcoming 23<sup>rd</sup> January.

**LOCATION**

**Airports :**

- Brussels International airport (Zaventem) : this airport served by the major airline companies is the biggest airport in Belgium. It is located near Brussels, approximately 100 km far from Mol. The trip by train from Brussels International airport to Mol railway station lasts 1h45 (€ 10.--). The trip by taxi lasts more or less 1h20 (approximately € 100.--).
- Eindhoven airport (Netherlands): Eindhoven airport served by the main airline companies is 50 km far from the city of Mol. Mol is reachable in 50 minutes by taxi and the approximate cost of the trip is € 60.--.
- Maastricht airport, Antwerp : this airport is located at 115 km far from Mol (1h15 by car).

**Train :**

The city of Mol has very good rail links - 2h45 from London (UK), 2h15 from Köln (GER), 1h25 from Paris (FRA) and 2h45 from Amsterdam (NED).

**By car :**

The city of Mol is only 20 minutes by car from the major Belgian highways (E34 and E313). It is located 75 km far from Brussels, 157 km from Köln, 370 km from Paris and 43 km from Eindhoven.

**Licence holders** : The participants must bring an officially recognised UCI licence.

**Delivery of race numbers** : From 08.30 a.m. till 02.00 p.m. at the Provinciaal Domein Zilvermeer.

**Circuit** : The course is 2.600 meters long. There will not be many running areas, only on the beach at the lake. The double pit area is indicated.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

1. The winner of each category receives the corresponding official UCI world jersey.
2. The first three riders of each category will be honoured and will receive the corresponding medal.
3. A minimum of 6 riders per category is necessary to have a series in the World Masters Cyclo Cross Championships. The organizers, in consultation with the Jury, can join categories.
4. Each participant receives a certificate as a souvenir of these Championships.
5. UCI will appoint an international commissaire as President of the Jury's Panel.
6. UCI will appoint a Doping Control Officer who will be responsible for the anti-doping controls.
7. Track will be available for training from 18<sup>th</sup> January.
8. Participants from foreign nations are requested to bring along a national flag and the national anthem on cassette or CD.
9. **All riders who hold a Masters licence may ride in the masters world championships with the following exceptions:**
  1. Any rider who has ridden in the UCI world championships, continental championships or UCI world cup during the current season.
  2. Any rider, who has been a member, during the current season, of a team registered with the UCI.
  3. During the current season, any rider classified in the UCI individual cyclo-cross classification published following the national championships in Europe.
