

## UCI FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

### General

#### UCI International Calendar

For a better understanding, the registration fee of every race has been subdivided into 3 parts:

#### 1. UCI fee

This fee includes allowances (expenses and travel) for Officials (International Commissaires, Doping Control Officers, Classifiers and Technical Delegates) appointed by the UCI and enrolment fee for each race on the international calendar.

The accommodation expenses (room + breakfast) remain payable by each organiser.

The total amount of these fees must be paid in Euros, within the term described in the article 1.2.012. (see also terms of payment).

#### 2. Annual contribution to the Cycling Anti-doping Foundation (CADF) (organisers)

The annual financial contribution of each organiser to the financing of the fight against doping and prevention is calculated on the basis of 5% of the UCI fee.

#### 3. Annual contribution to the Cycling Anti-doping Foundation (CADF) (riders)

The contribution from the riders is equal to the 2% of the minimum prize money scale.

*This financial contribution should be deducted from the prizes which the organisers pay to the riders.*

The invoicing of the financial contribution for riders of road races:

- part of the UCI ProTour
- part of the World calendar, Historic events
- part of the Continental calendars, classes HC et 1

2% of the real prize money (PM) will be sent directly to the paying agency of the prize money (Riders association or National Federation).

*This financial contribution should be deducted from the prizes which the organisers pay to the riders.*

#### Fund of end-of-career allowances (CPA)

A contribution of 7% of the real prize money (PM) of road races

- part of the UCI ProTour
- part of the World calendar, Historic events
- part of the Continental calendars, classes HC and 1

is invoiced to the paying agencies as contribution to the fund of end-of-career allowances of road professional riders.

*This financial contribution should be deducted from the prizes which the organisers pay to the riders.*

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#### Team

##### 2.16.011

By 1 September prior to the registration year, the team applying for professional continental team status must submit the following to UCI headquarters :

AI.2

The payment of the registration fee into the UCI account.

In the event of delay the registration fee will automatically be increased by 500 Swiss francs per day.

#### International Calendar fee

##### 1.2.012

The inclusion of a race on the international calendar shall be subject to the payment of a fee, called the calendar fee, the amount of which shall be set annually by the UCI management committee.

The total amount of the fee must be paid by the organiser to the UCI no later than two months after the meeting of the management committee at which the calendar for the discipline in question is approved. The above deadline is the date on which the UCI account must be credited.

In case of delay, a penalty of 100 Swiss francs for each started month will automatically be applied.

The inclusion of the race on the following calendar shall be refused should the fee, as well as the penalty not have been paid one month before the meeting of the management committee at which the calendar in question is approved.

Furthermore, a race inscription shall be refused if the enrolment fees for previous races have not been paid or if the organiser does not honour its financial obligations with the UCI. This measure also applies to the new organiser of the race and, in general, to the organiser and/or race that the management committee considers to be the successor of another organiser or another race.

#### Fines

##### 12.1.027

The **amount of the** fines cited in the UCI Regulations **is given** in Swiss francs (CHF). In the case of payment in any other currency, the sum transmitted shall **correspond at least to** the amount in CHF, net of all expenses, at the current rate on the **day of the payment**.

##### 12.1.029

Fines due to the UCI shall be paid within one month of the **notification of invoice**.

If payment is not received by the due date, the total amount of the fine shall automatically be increased by 20%.

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#### Scale of penalties

#### For Continental confederation other than Europe

Confederation	Scale of penalties
African Cycling Confederation	50%
Oceanian Cycling Confederation	60%
Panamerican Cycling Confederation	Road - Class 2 - 50%
Asian Cycling Confederation	Asia 1: 100% Asia 2: 33%

- Percentages refer to the amounts mentioned on the UCI Regulations.
- All the races enrolled on World Calendar are subjected to the 100% rate.
