



Airport Transport

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation to and from the International Airport Don Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla to the Victoria Express Hotel and Carlton Hotel for national teams. Transportation will be provided by the Organizing Committee on Monday 13 January. All national teams arriving before this date may be charged for this service. UCI Registered teams may be charged an airport transfer fee should they wish to use the Organising Committee transport. UCI Registered teams should indicate if they wish to access OC transport.
