General information about the region

Elzach is situated in southwest Germany in the mountain region of Black Forest at a distance of 30 km from Freiburg, 100 km from Basle (Switzerland), 150 km from Stuttgart, 180 km from Zurich (Switzerland) and 250 km from Frankfurt.

Elzach is about 175 km (2 hours car ride) away from Nottwil (Switzerland) where the World Championships will take place from 28th July till 2nd August 2015.

The Black Forest in the southwest corner of Germany is home to some of the most beautiful scenery in Germany. Its 11,400 square kilometers are home to a rapidly changing landscape, with forests in the north, the less dense central Black Forest, and the mountainous south that leads down to the Rhine.

Black Forest visitors will find rich and varied landscapes, a diverse selection of health and spa resorts, delicious regional food, cultural and architectural treasures, especially in local cities, living regional traditions and a big variety of country sports such as hiking, Nordic walking, mountain biking and cycling, horse riding and golf.

Southwest Germany has a passion for cycling races. Cyclists can find brilliant conditions for training in the Rhine River Plain and the broad valleys as well as on the panorama and high altitude roads. In between a fair amount of physical challenge with climbs up to 3,000 ft/1,000 m.

Average temperature in July: min 13°C

Transportation

How to reach the venue:

By plane:

The main International/national airport is Frankfurt, located ~250 km from the start finish area.

Alternative airports:

Stuttgart: ~ 150 km

Basle (Switzerland): ~ 100 km

Zurich (Switzerland): ~ 180 km

By train:

Elzach has a train station and is hourly connected with Freiburg.

By road:

From Nord (Frankfurt) take the Autobahn A5 exit Offenburg and continue B33 and B294 for about 40 km to Elzach.

From South (Zurich/Basle) take the Autobahn A5 exit Freiburg-Nord and continue B294 for about 30 km to Elzach.

From East (Stuttgart) take the Autobahn A81 exit Rottweil and continue via B462 to Schramberg. Then turn into L108 via Hornberg and L107 to Elzach.

Race description

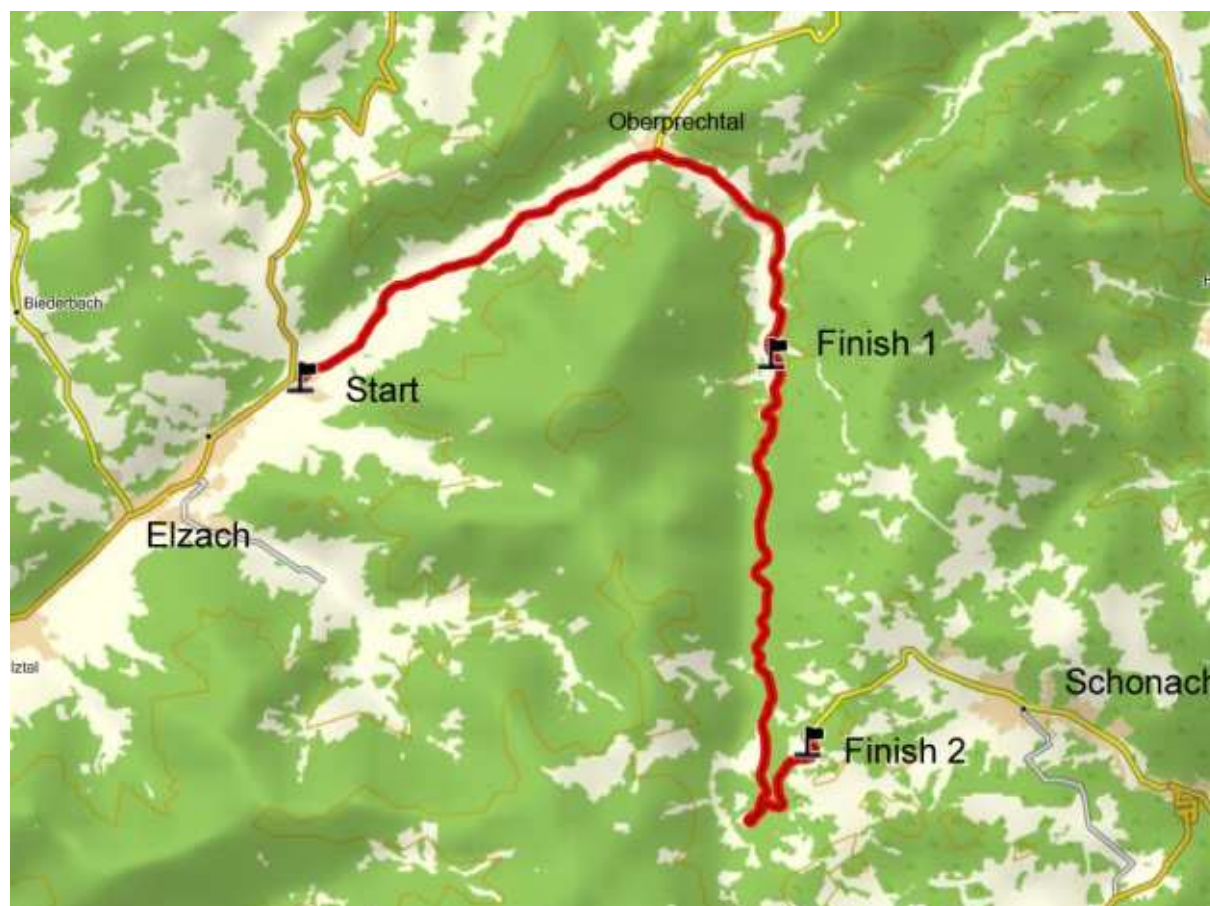
Individual Time Trial

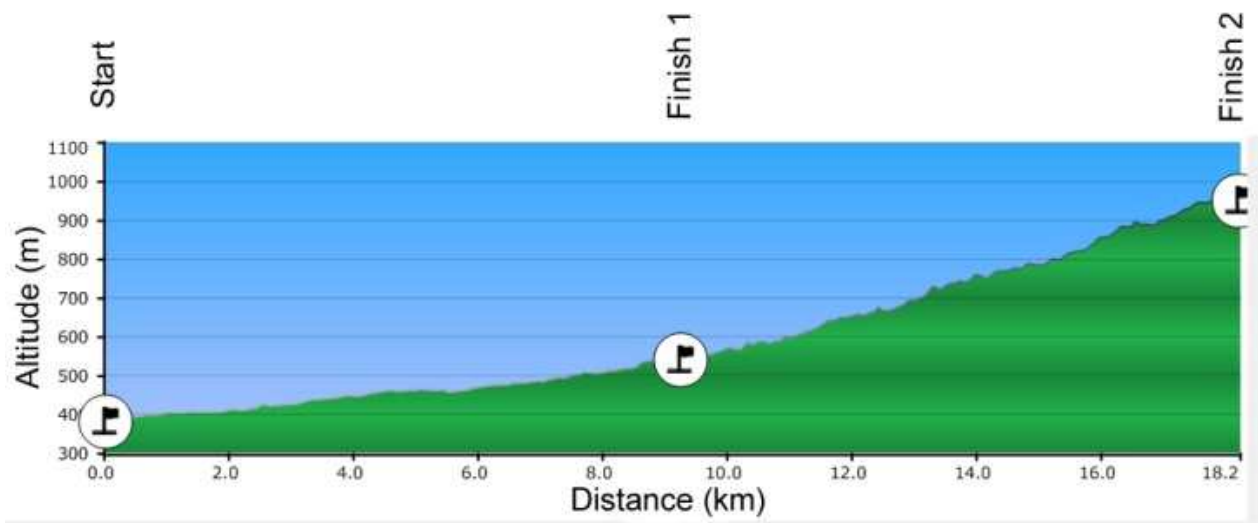
The time trials competition start will be held on Schrahöfe, 79215 Elzach. (2 km distance from Elzach). Start is at 381 m above sea level. Finish 1 at 545 m and Finish 2 at 957 m above sea level.

The course is no circuit. Therefore there are two finish lines as follows:

Finish 1 at 9,0 km Classes: MH1-5; WH1-5, TM1-2, TW1-2
Finish 2 at 18,2 km Classes: MB, MW, MC1-5, WC1-5

The first 6 km are at a moderate ascent of 2%. After the village of Oberprechtal the ascent increases slightly up to 4 % till finish 1. Between finish 1 and 2 the ascent increases again. The last 3 km will be at a maximum of 9%.



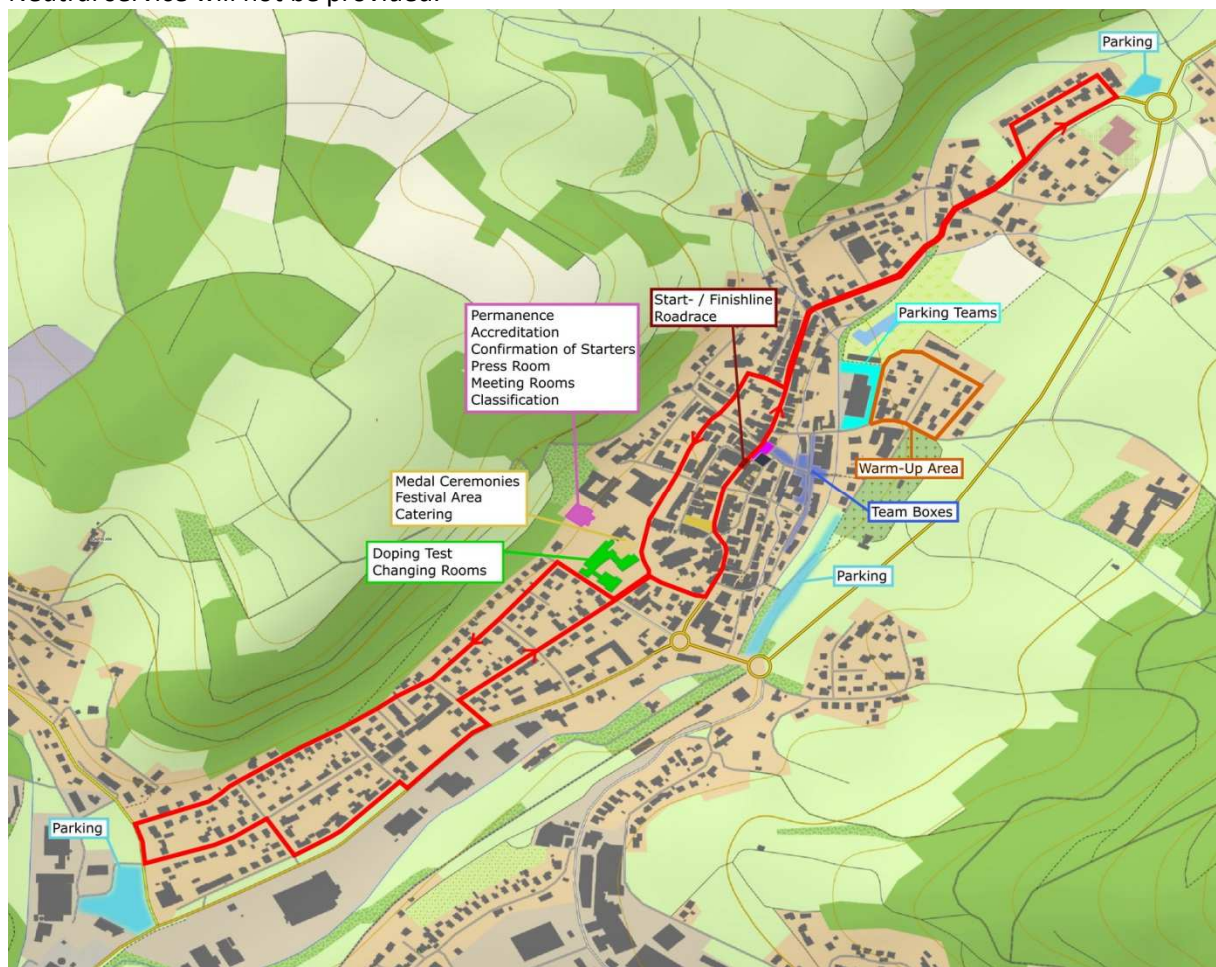


Road Race

Lap: 4,6 km – to be covered several times according to the category in which the cyclist will be compete. Start/Finish-Line will be at Hauptstraße 67, D-79215 Elzach.

The road race will take place in the city centre of Elzach. The circuit is flat and fast.

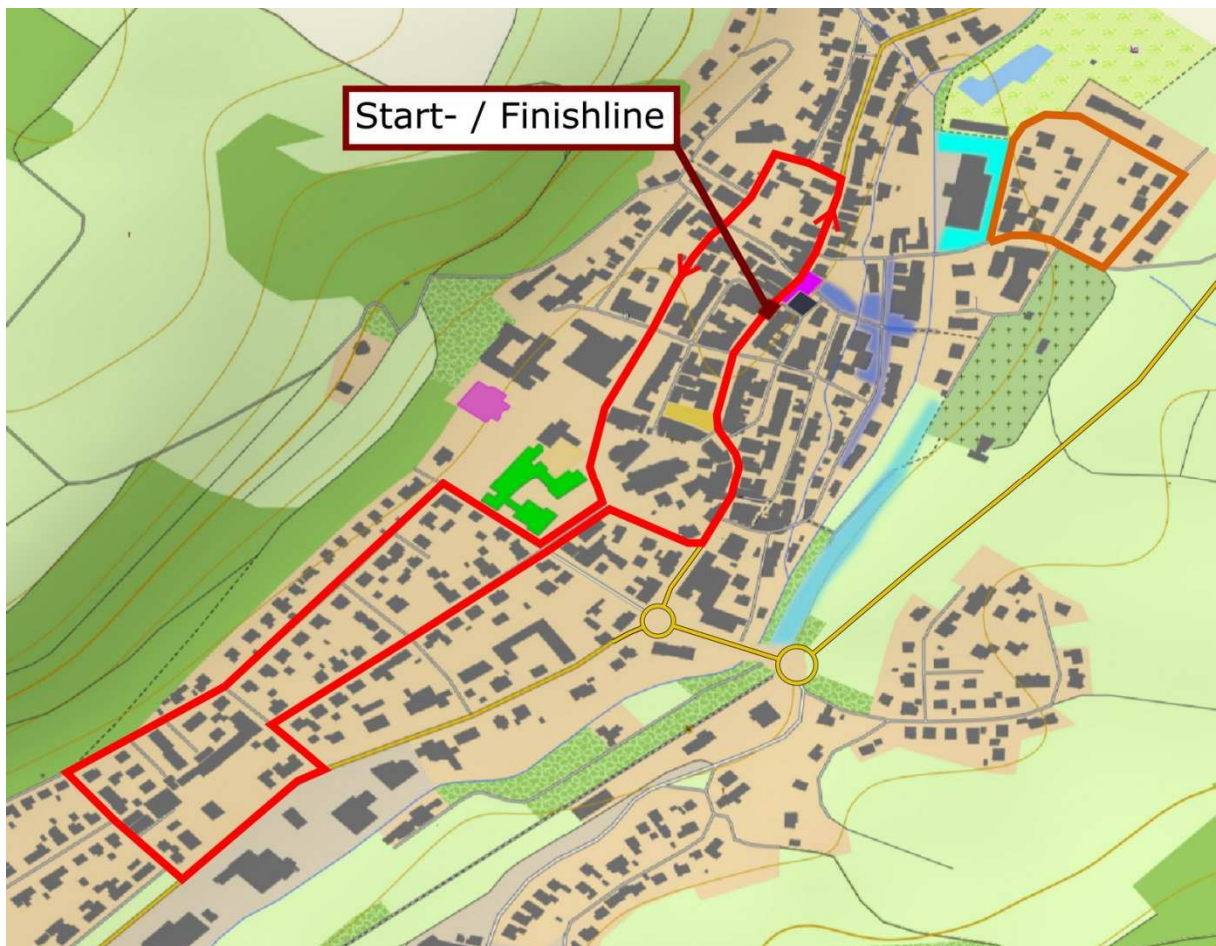
Neutral service will not be provided.



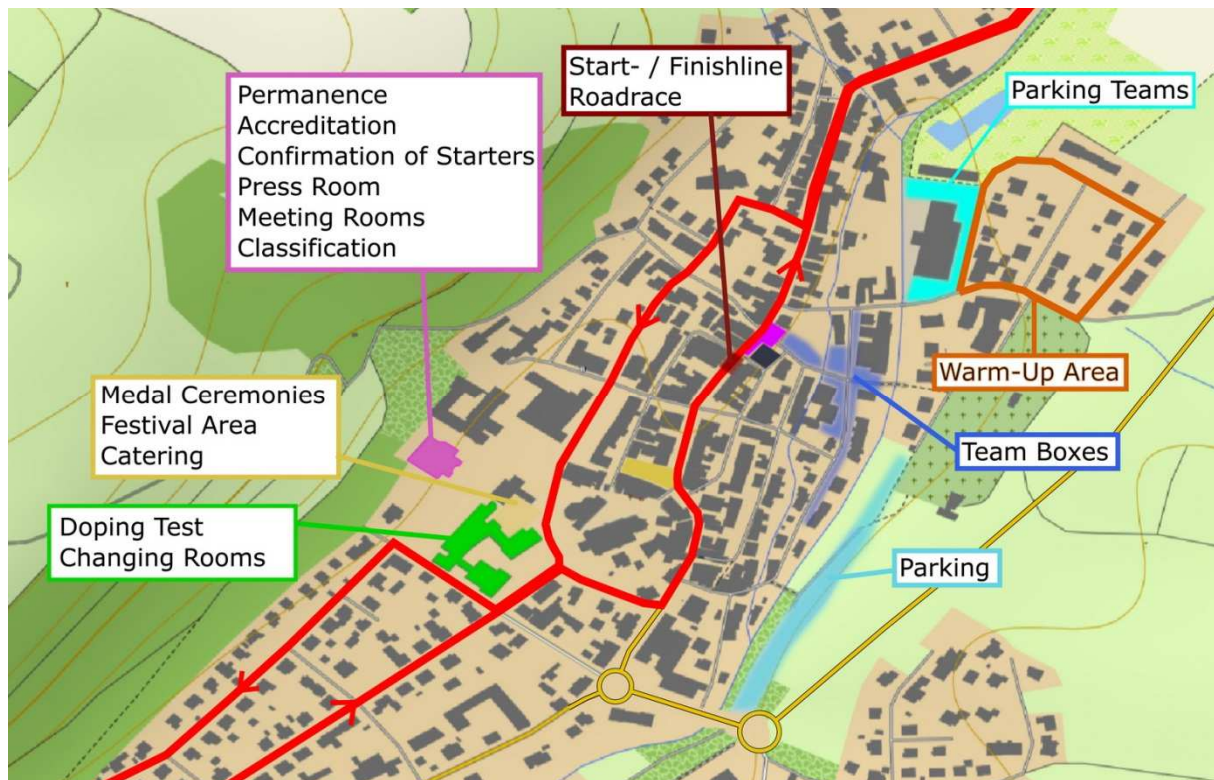


Team Relay, 2,3 km Lap

Registration fee for National Federations

The competition will take place under UCI regulations

In reference to the UCI regulations (art. 16.20.006) registration shall take place on both the UCI online registration website ([http://regonline.uci.ch/ layouts/login_Onlineservices.aspx?ReturnUrl=%2f](http://regonline.uci.ch/layouts/login_Onlineservices.aspx?ReturnUrl=%2f)) and through the organiser by filling out the registration form (www.worldcup-elzach.com):

The UCI online registration begins 5 weeks (18.6.15) before the event 12:00=(GMT+1) and closes 3 weeks before the event (2.7.15).

National Federations shall confirm their participation by means of an enrolment form not later than three weeks before the first race of the World Cup. At the time of registration, up to six substitutes can be added on the team for all classes combined. This confirmation shall mention the number of persons making up each delegation, registration of riders in each race as well as their sport class, accommodation used during the event, full coordinates of the team responsible and each athlete's time of arrival.

After the registration deadline 2.7.2015 (3 weeks before the world cup), late registrations may be accepted not later than 10 days prior to the start of the competition, and in exceptional circumstances only. In the event of late registration, a payment of CHF 100 per rider per day late is due. After this deadline, no late registration will be accepted any more.



Starters must be confirmed in each sport class during the official confirmation time as announced in the technical program of the event. A single representative for each National Federation shall proceed to confirm the starters for all the athletes of that nation, whether they are participating through the national team, as individuals or for any other team under the recommendation of the National Federation.

There is a register fee of € 75,00 per accreditation request. No refunds will be given except in cases of emergency, as accepted by the organization and will be paid in cash at the event.

Chips/Transponder:

The Organising Committee will provide the Team Manager with a Chip/Transponder for each athlete competing, with a caution fee of € 30.00 each. At the end of the competition the transponder must be returned in exchange for the deposit.

Insurance:

Each team is responsible for insuring its athletes. It is compulsory that this cover:

- Damage to property, personal injuries and /or health problems, third-party liabilities

The Organising Committee is not responsible for the material stored or for any loss.

Free Official training

The roads will be open for public during training sessions. Traffic is not stopped. Handbike riders must use a caution/safety flag while training.
