Rules Amendments applying on **01.07.2018**

Chapter II PARTICIPATION IN WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 9.1.008** The application shall reach UCI ~~within the period set forth in the bidding procedure Headquarters at least three years before 1 January of the year on which the Championships at issue are to be held.~~

§ 2 Selection of participants by specialty

Cyclo-cross

- 9.2.043** The maximum number of riders per men **and women** elite's national team shall be determined by the final **ranking** by nation of the UCI cyclo-cross **ranking** for the preceding season:

Nations ranked from 1st to 5th	9 riders, with 6 to start
All other nations	8 riders, with 5 to start.

In the other categories, the number of riders per team is limited to 8, with 5 to start.

- 9.2.045** ~~Each federation shall be required to include its first three ranked riders in their men elite's and women's team, as long as they are in the top 50 of the UCI cyclo-cross ranking as published after the national championships in Europe.~~

~~This rule shall not apply to riders who have failed to fulfil their obligations under the regulations. In the event of a dispute on this issue, it shall be the responsibility of the national federation to decide whether the rider will be selected.~~

Para-cycling (participation)

9.2.062 National Federations ~~shall confirm the number of participants per sport class by means of the UCI online registration system no later than five weeks before the first races of the championship. The registration by names shall be done~~ register their riders through the same **online** registration system no later than three weeks before the first race of the event. At the time of registration, up to six substitutes can be added to the team for all classes combined. The registration shall give details of the number of persons making up each delegation, the riders registered for each race as well as their sport class, the accommodation used during the event, full contact details of the team manager and each athlete's time of arrival.

After the registration deadline (3 weeks before the world championships), ~~no late registrations will be accepted~~ late registrations will be invoiced CHF 200.- per athlete.

Starters must be confirmed in each sport class at the official confirmation time as announced in the technical programme of the event.

Last-minute changes of registered athletes can only be achieved by means of a medical certificate 24 hours before the start of the race.
